This Vendor Application and Indemnification Agreement is entered into as of the date listed above between Vendor and Event Sponsor.

The undersigned Vendor desires to attend the Event listed above to engage in retail sales to the general public; and

Vendor represents that it has the appropriate licenses to market and sell its goods/services, and that it is responsible for abiding by all federal, state and local laws and ordinances, and breach of any such laws or ordinances will result in the revocation of its license/authority to attend the Event; and

Vendor represents that it will be responsible for keeping the area around its booth/truck safe and free from any hazardous conditions that are likely to result in bodily injury to a member of the general public;

Therefore, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, Vendor and Event Sponsor hereby agree as follows:

1. Vendor has full legal authority to market and sell the goods/services being sold at Event.
2. Vendor is responsible for abiding by all federal, state and local laws and ordinances and understands that the breach of any such laws or ordinances will result in the immediate revocation of its license to attend Event.
3. Vendor is responsible for keeping the immediate area around its booth/truck safe and free from any hazardous conditions that are foreseeable or likely to result in bodily injury to a member of the general public and understands that the failure

to keep the immediate area around its booth/truck safe and free from foreseeable hazardous conditions will result in the immediate revocation of its Rental Spot and fee in non refundable.

4. Vendor hereby indemnifies and holds harmless Event Sponsor against any and all claims (and expenses, including attorneys' fees incurred relating thereto) made against Event Sponsor at any time with respect to the Vendor or the Vendor's booth or food truck. Specifically, this indemnity includes any and all claims relating to personal injuries or property damage sustained as a result of purchasing goods or services from the Vendor or physically attending the Vendor's booth or truck. This indemnity shall survive the end of the Event.
